

ORDINANCE NO. 2023 - 137

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 5: BUSINESS REGULATIONS

**WHEREAS**, the City of Georgetown, Illinois, a municipal corporation, acting through its corporate authorities, regulates the use and operation of food trucks for the purpose of preserving the safety of the residents living within the corporate jurisdiction of the City, and preserving the peace, good order, and comfort, convenience, and welfare of the inhabitants of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Georgetown has the authority to establish a permit system and fees for operation of food trucks within its city limits;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Georgetown, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** This ordinance amends Title 5 of the Municipal Code of the City of Georgetown by adding Chapter 5.46 - Food Trucks.

**Section 2.** Subsection 5.46.010 - Definitions is hereby added, as follows:

"A Food Truck is any vehicle or trailer from which food is sold or served."

**Section 3.** Subsection 5.46.020 - License Required is hereby added, as follows:

"No Food Truck shall be operated for gain within the city limits unless it has been issued a Food Truck Permit from the City Clerk."

**Section 4.** Subsection 5.46.025 - Application is hereby added, as follows:

"Application for a Food Truck Permit shall be made in writing to the City Clerk upon the form provided by the City Clerk."

**Section 5.** Subsection 5.46.030 - Fee is hereby added, as follows:

"The permit fee for each Food Truck shall be two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) per Food Truck, per year. A business operating multiple Food Trucks shall be required to obtain a separate permit for each Food Truck operated."

**Section 6.** Subsection 5.46.040 - Penalty is hereby added, as follows:

"The penalty for operation of a Food Truck without a permit shall be one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per day. One warning shall be issued to a first time offender."

**Section 7.** Subsection 5.46.050 - Exemption is hereby added, as follows:

"The provisions of this Chapter 5.46 shall not apply to Georgetown Fair vendors during fair week."

**Section 8.** This ordinance shall take effect on January 2, 2024, or the soonest date thereafter as allowed by law.

**Section 9.** The City Clerk is empowered to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

**Section 10.** This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, by a majority of the members of the City Council of the City of Georgetown, at a regular meeting of the Council on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of January, 2024.
