Chairman M. Scott declared a quorum was present.

- Chairman M. Scott discussed the issues around Park St. Parents are not able to use the west parking lot at the jr. high to turn around. They are going around the block Dyke to Franklin or Penn. Chairman M. Scott would like to put a stop at on Park and one on Penn to help with the traffic. The council also asked about the police patrolling the area.
- The Pine Crest pick up line continues to be an issue. Are police patrolling the area during pick up? Treasurer Cavanaugh was asked about the schools plans for the area. She said there has been a lot of talk about adding a road, but the school is currently operating on a deficit budget. It is still in the works, but not sure when it will happen. Alder Waterman asked if they had an estimate. The TIF district can grant another taxing district money. Chairman M. Scott would like to ask Dr. Neal to come to the next meeting to discuss the schools' plans. The council also mentioned that the police need to be writing violations. An ambulance had to park and walk with the stretcher down Mitchell Dr. due to care blocking the road.
- Chairman M. Scott mentioned the parking along the street on the first block of E. West. This has become a public safety issue. There have been many close calls from people trying to pull out from the bank or memorial parking lot. The committee would like to recommend not allowing any parking in the first block of E. West. There will be a delivery zone.
