CITY OF GEORGETOWN, ILLINOIS ORDINANCE NO. 2024 - 144

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10: VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

WHEREAS, the City of Georgetown, Illinois, a municipal corporation, acting through its corporate authorities, regulates vehicles and traffic for the purpose of preserving the safety of the residents living within the corporate jurisdiction of the City, and preserving the peace, good order, and comfort, convenience, and welfare of the inhabitants of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Georgetown has the authority to regulate nuisance motor vehicles within its city limits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Georgetown, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. This ordinance amends Title 10, Chapter 10.29 of the Municipal Code of the City of Georgetown and to the extent that said chapter, or any portion thereof, is inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, the same are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Subsection 10.29.060(A) is hereby repealed, and the following is substituted in its stead:

"Whenever a motor vehicle is used in the commission of or in conjunction with any of the offenses described in Section 10.29.010(A) hereof, the motor vehicle may be impounded and the owner of record of the motor vehicle shall be liable for an administrative penalty in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) in addition to all applicable towing and storage fees."

Section 3. The penalty established pursuant to this Ordinance shall apply to all violations occurring at least ten (10) days after publication of this Ordinance.

Section 4. The City Clerk is empowered to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, by a majority of the members of the City Council of the City of Georgetown, at a regular meeting of the Council on the 20 day of _______, 2024.
