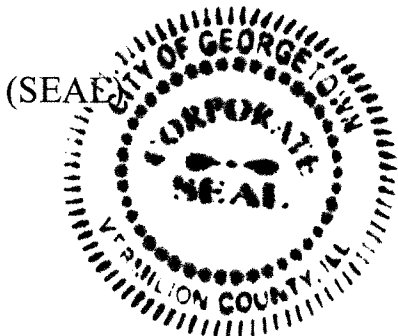

An Ordinance Amending Title 5:
Business Regulations

WHEREAS Title 5, Chapter 5.20 of the City of Georgetown Code of Ordinances (hereinafter the "City Code") currently specifies various regulations for solicitation activities within the City of Georgetown; and

WHEREAS the City of Georgetown now desires to amend Title 5, Chapter 5.20 of the City Code regarding solicitation activities within the City; and

WHEREAS the City Council, after considerable thought and deliberation, has determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Georgetown to amend Title 5, Chapter 5.20 of the City code in the manner set forth hereinbelow.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Georgetown, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated by reference herein as express findings of fact.

Section 2. This ordinance amends Title 5, Chapter 5.20. To the extent that the provisions of Title 5 or any portion thereof are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Section 5.20.050 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"5.20.050 - License - Application - Issuance.

Application for license shall be made to the City Clerk. Applicants shall provide all information as requested on the application form provided by the City Clerk. All statements made by the applicant upon the application and in connection therewith shall be under oath. A separate application shall be made for each individual.

The City shall require every applicant or individual who will be engaged in solicitation activities on behalf of the applicant within the City to submit to a fingerprint background check through the Illinois State Police. The City shall provide the applicant with contact information for approved fingerprint vendors, along with requirements for submission of the fingerprints to the Illinois State Police.

The results of the Illinois State Police background check shall be submitted to the City by the applicant along with their application.

Each applicant shall, along with their application, submit a bond in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) with sureties satisfactory to the city council. The City Clerk shall submit the application and bond to the City Council at a regularly convened meeting for approval.

Only after all fees have been paid and the fingerprint background check reports have been reviewed and approved by the City Council will the Clerk issue the license, which shall indicate the dates and times approved for sales or solicitations."

Section 4. Section 5.20.060 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"5.20.060 - License - Fee.

Upon making an application for a License, the applicant shall pay a non-refundable application fee in the amount of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per person, per day engaged in the solicitation activities, as specified in the application."


Section 5. The City Clerk is empowered to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption, execution and publication as provided by law, or as soon thereafter as allowed by law.

Section 7. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, by a majority of the members of the City Council of the City of Georgetown, Illinois, at a regular meeting of the Council on the 1st day of July, 2024


