**AN ORDINANCE REGARDING DUMPING OF LANDSCAPING AND TREE
SERVICE WASTE AT THE DAM**

WHEREAS the City of Georgetown, Illinois, a municipal corporation, acting through its corporate authorities, has in the past allowed free access to the dam yard waste site for dumping of yard waste, landscaping waste and tree service waste; and

WHEREAS the City of Georgetown, in order to maintain the safe and orderly flow of waste at the dam site, has the authority to regulate use of and access to the dam site for dumping purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Georgetown, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. This ordinance amends Title 5 - BUSINESS REGULATIONS, by adding Chapter 5.5 - LANDSCAPING AND TREE REMOVAL DUMPING AT DAM, and to the extent that said chapter or any portion thereof are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, the same are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Subsection 5.5.001 is hereby added, as follows:

"It shall be unlawful, and a violation of this ordinance, for Landscaping Companies and Tree Removal Companies to dump landscaping waste and tree waste at the yard waste area at the dam without first obtaining a permit therefor pursuant to this Section 5.5. For the purposes of this Section 5.5, a Landscaping Company shall be any

company or individual engaged in the business of providing landscaping services to others within the city limits of Georgetown, IL. For the purposes of this Section 5.5, a Tree Removal Company shall be defined as any company or individual engaged in the business of providing tree trimming or removal services to others within the city limits of Georgetown, IL."

Section 3. Subsection 5.5.002 is hereby added, as follows:

"The cost for an annual landscaping waste dumping permit shall be \$50.00. The permit period shall be from January 1st to December 31st. The cost of the permit shall not be prorated for permits acquired after January 1st."

Section 4. Subsection 5.5.003 is hereby added, as follows:

"The cost for an annual tree waste dumping permit shall be \$100.00. The permit period shall be from January 1st to December 31st. The cost of the permit shall not be prorated for permits acquired after January 1st."

Section 5. The City Clerk is empowered to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication, or as soon thereafter as allowed by law.

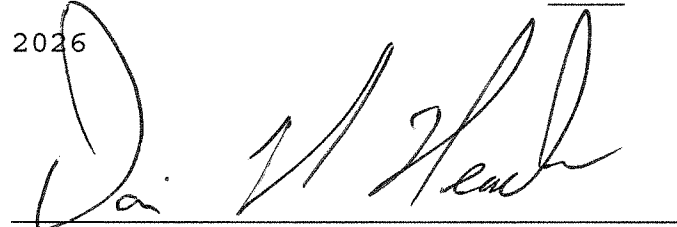

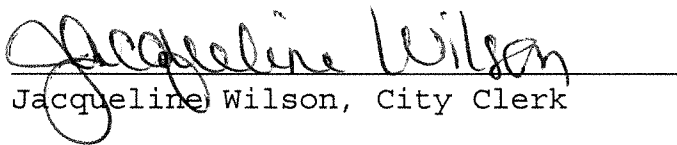
